Here you find my best attempt so far at summarizing the mobile market. I started with browsers, because that's my specialty, but then the table branched off into other directions almost by itself.

In principle the table only treats the smartphone space, but some feature phone vendors are branching off into that space, and I do want to keep an eye on the possibility that one of these OSs breaks through to the smartphone market.

Currently the table contains 21 browsers, 15 OSs, and 14 device vendors.

It does not always make sense to compare two columns; for instance, the proliferation and OS vendor columns have very little to do with each other. I'm counting on your common sense here.

I will add more information, such as about the app stores, when I've solved certain technical difficulties in the data-reading script. I may also add market share numbers for device vendors and OSs when I figure out how to display them.

“The control which designers know in the print medium, and often desire in the web medium, is simply a function of the limitation of the printed page. We should embrace the fact that the web doesn't have the same constraints, and design for this flexibility. But first, we must “accept the ebb and flow of things.”

The English architect Christopher Wren once quipped that his chosen field “aims for Eternity,” and there’s something appealing about that formula: Unlike the web, which often feels like aiming for next week, architecture is a discipline very much defined by its permanence. A building’s foundation defines its footprint, which defines its frame, which shapes the facade. Each phase of the architectural process is more immutable, more unchanging than the last. Creative decisions quite literally shape a physical space, defining the way in which people move through its confines for decades or even centuries.

Working on the web, however, is a wholly different matter. Our work is defined by its transience, often refined or replaced within a year or two. Inconsistent window widths, screen resolutions, user preferences, and our users’ installed fonts are but a few of the intangibles

### What They Needed

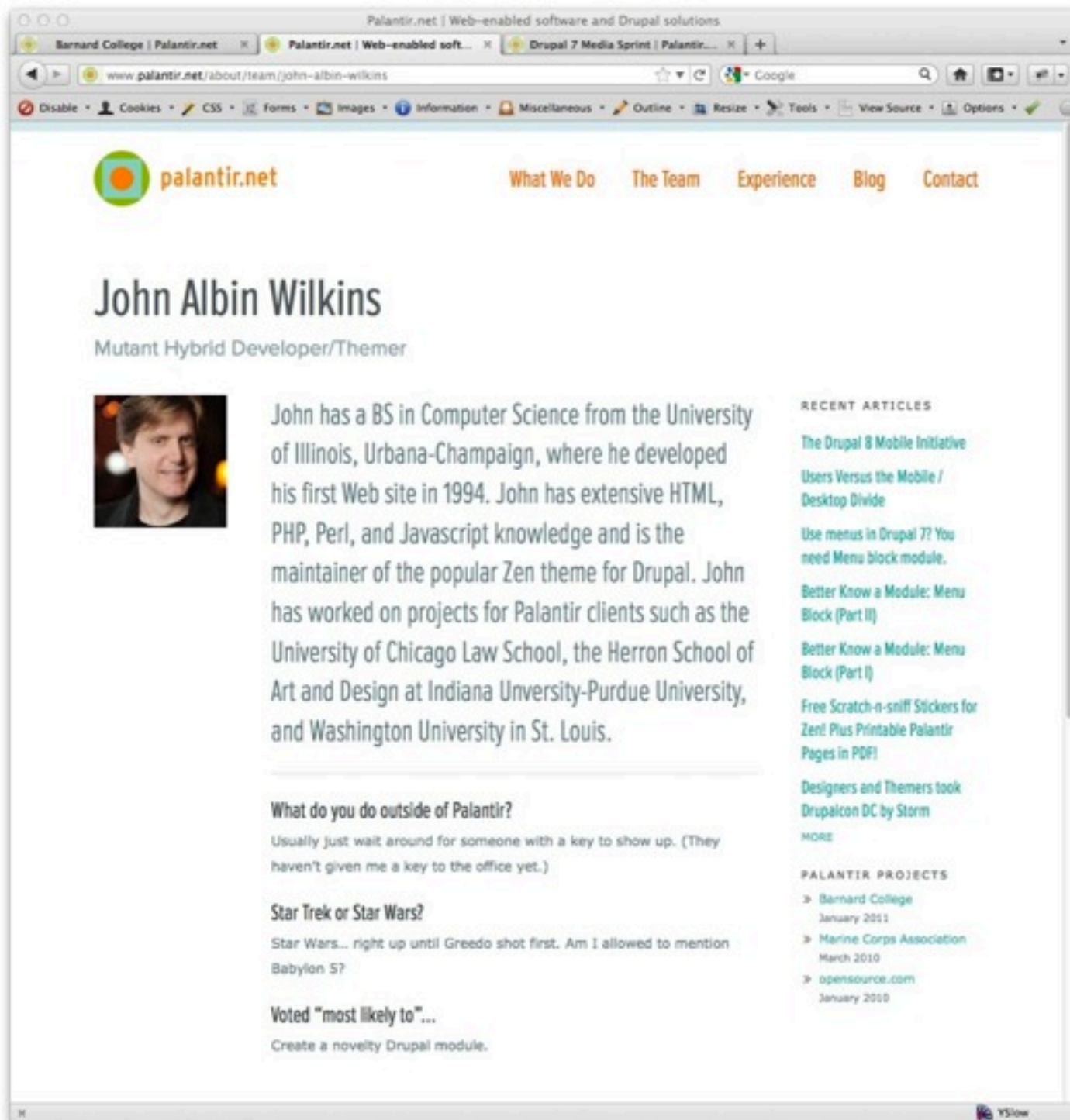
With dozens of subsites supported by hundreds of content contributors, Barnard needed an elegant, agile solution for maintaining and updating their Web presence. Palantir worked closely with Barnard to develop a solution that not only enabled site administrators to oversee the school's entire site, but also empowered non-technical contributors to easily update content within their own individual sections.

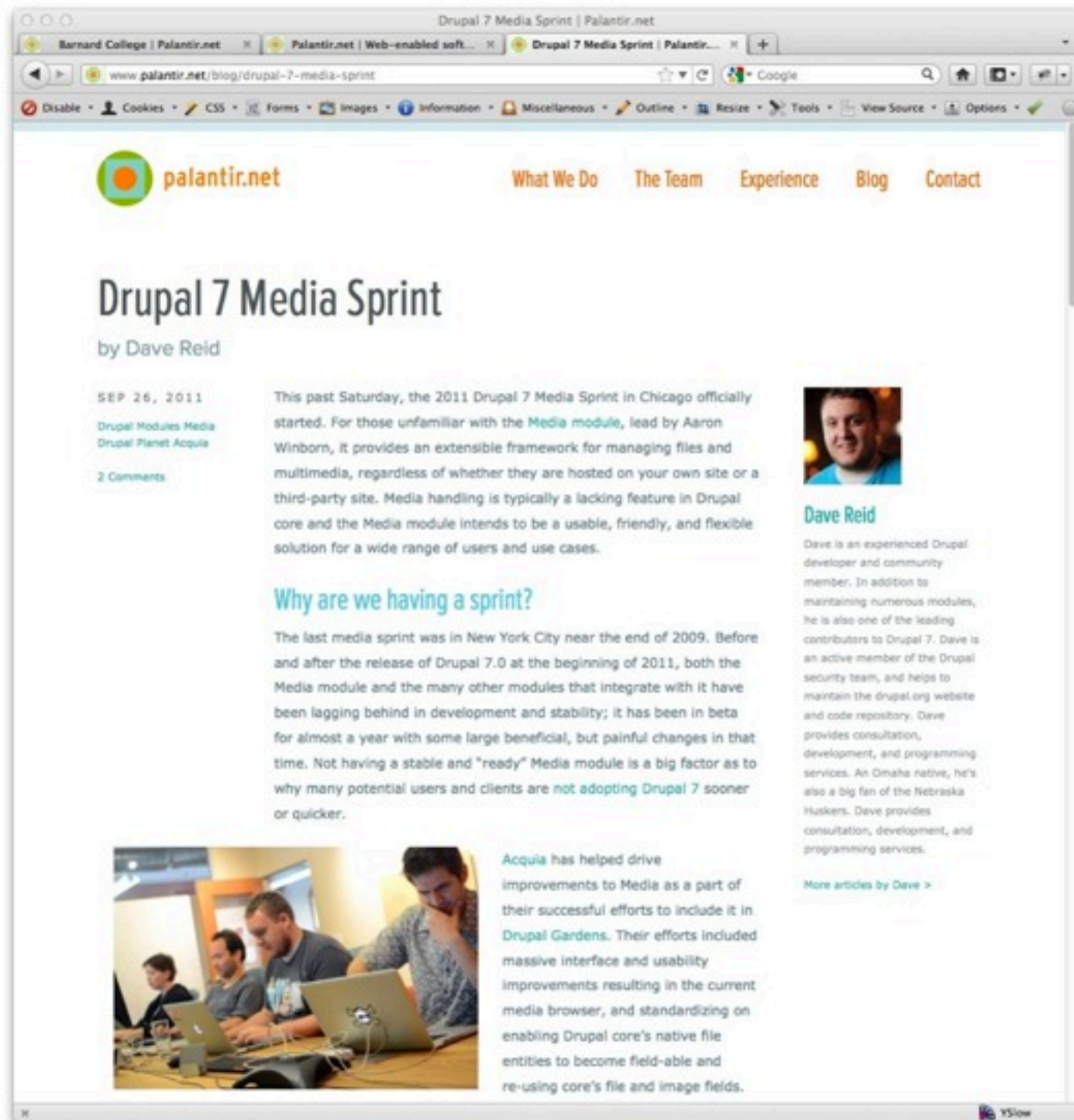
Each one of Barnard's nearly 50 departments and programs has its own subsite, maintained by its own set of content contributors and editors. Each one of these sites needed to have its own unique visual identity, while still fitting into the overall Barnard branding.

Many of Barnard's content contributors and editors are responsible for multiple "sections" of the site that don't necessarily correspond to the site's menu system or information hierarchy. Some content contributors have their copy reviewed by one or more editors before it is published live on the site. Barnard needed a way to assign rights to various types of users so that content could be created, reviewed, revised, and published across sections of the site









## Drupal 7 Media Sprint

SEP 26, 2011

This past Saturday, the 2011 Drupal 7 Media Sprint in Chicago officially started. For those unfamiliar with the [Media module](#), lead by Aaron Winborn, it provides an extensible framework for managing files and multimedia, regardless of whether they are hosted on your own site or a third-party site. Media handling is typically a lacking feature in Drupal core and the Media module intends to be a usable, friendly, and flexible solution for a wide range of users and use cases.

The last media sprint was in New York City near the end of 2009. Before and after the release of Drupal 7.0 at the beginning of 2011, both the Media module and the many other modules that integrate with it have been lagging behind in development and stability; it has been in beta for almost a year with some large beneficial, but painful changes in that time. Not having a stable and "ready" Media module is a big factor as to why many potential users and clients are not adopting Drupal 7 sooner or quicker.
