With dozens of subsites supported by hundreds of content contributors, Barnard needed an elegant, agile solution for maintaining and updating their Web presence. Last week I wrote about why I was considering teaching the noscript technique in our book and asked for someone to talk me out of it before I committed what I feared would be a long-lasting crime against web development.

The post worked. I got some great feedback, and I've decided against using noscript in the book.

Instead, I'm going to use <u>Sencha.io SRC</u> (aka TinySRC) in the book. Much to my surprise, it seems like the most future friendly option.

The problem with the noscript version

Sometimes I need something explained to me multiple times before I get it.

Understanding why using noscript was a problem for semantic markup was one of those times.

Fortunately, <u>Stephen Hay</u> got through my thick skull with this paragraph from an email he sent:
